OPEN SHOW

All open and junior show sheep may enter fair grounds after 5 p.m. on Wednesday, August 4 but must be on the grounds by 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 5. Market lambs must be on the grounds by 6:00 p.m., Friday, August 6.

All sheep to be entitled to a premium must be entered in the class and must be registered in their respective breed association in the name of the exhibitor. All registration papers must be shown to the superintendent upon request at time of entry onto the fair grounds. The exception to the registration papers will be for the market lamb class.

Each exhibitor will be allowed 4 entries per immediate family, partnership, firm, or corporation in the individual classes. (Limit of two premiums will be awarded per class). All entries in pair or group class must be entered in their respective individual class to exhibited. No marking of pen's - pairs - flocks. All animals must be presented for premium.

THE CLASSIFICATION - ALL OTHER BREEDS REGISTRATION PAPERS AND FLOCK TAGS WILL BE CHECKED BY SHEEP SUPERINTENDENT ON THURSDAY AT 1:00 P.M.

All sheep must be washed and trimmed with the exception of the wool breeds and they must be trimmed and otherwise prepared for show.

No entries will be made by the secretary after Tuesday, July 27. Seven days before the opening of the fair. Mail your entries and monies to Livestock Supervisor, Knox County Fair, Box 204, Knoxville, IL 61448.

Each listed breed must have a minimum of two different exhibitors entered to qualify for competition showing and awarding of premiums in any particular breed. If less than two exhibitors for any one breed are entered, the superintendent will have the right to enter those breeds into a combined class for competitive judging and premium award.

Animals will not be released from the fairgrounds until Sunday. Exhibitors will be required to obtain a release certificate from the department superintendent before he loads his livestock. Release certificates are available at the secretary's office.

Shepherd Award

The Knox County Fair will present a shepherd award. This will be based on neatness of pen area, presentation of animal, the cooperation and congeniality of the exhibitor. This will be judged daily by an impartial committee.

All entries in pair or group class must be entered in their respective individual class to exhibit.

Entries due by 6 p.m.

Classes will be determined by Superintendents after weigh in.

Show starts at 7 p.m.

All market lambs will be released after show.
