Please read rules and regulations carefully.

Entries confined to Illinois resident to any boy or girl who will be 8 years of age by January 1 of the year in which they will show or will not be 21 years of age by Jan. 1 of the year in which they will show. Exhibitors are not required to belong to any group or to be members of 4-H or FFA Chapters. Exhibitors in this department must represent the work of Junior Exhibitors. No entries will be made after 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 27, SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE OPENING DAY OF THE FAIR. Mail your entries and checks to Livestock Supervisor, Knox County Fair, Box 204, Knoxville, Illinois.

All Breeding stock in Junior Beef Department must be registered in the name of the exhibitor. Registration papers and tattoos may be checked at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday. All other recorded Breed entries must also furnish registration papers and tattoos may be checked on Thursday at 10:00 a.m.

Animals shown in the Junior Show, registered in the name of the exhibitor, will be eligible to be shown in the Open Show in the Group classes, providing these Junior Exhibitors are members of the immediate family or firm exhibiting.

There must be 5 registered animals to make a breed. If there is not 5, animals will exhibit in the AOB classes.

All junior show steers will be inspected by the beef superintendents as to the validity of their breed. Crossbred steers must be shown as such, All Junior Show Steers entered in Simmental, Shorthorn, Hereford or Angus classes, will be required to furnish Land of Lincoln papers, Registration papers, or in the case of a steer bred in another state, breeder's certificate must be furnished. Every steer not accompanied by said certificate will be shown as a crossbred. Tattoos may be checked.

PENS MUST BE CLEANED AT DISMISSAL TO RECEIVE PREMIUMS. NO LIMIT ON ENTRIES IN EACH CLASS, HOWEVER, ONLY TWO PREMIUMS WILL BE PAID PER EXHIBITOR PER CLASS.

JUDGING STARTS 11:00 A.M. FRIDAY, IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER: SHORTHORN, ALL OTHER RECORDED BREEDS, HEREFORD, SIMMENTALS, ANGUS, MAINEANJOU.

EXHIBITORS PASS.....\$10.00

It is to be understood that any exhibitor making entries in both the Junior Show and the Open Show with the same animal will only be required to pay Stall or Pen Fees once.

See rules in Open Show for arrival time.

Animals will not be released from the Fairgrounds until Sunday. Exhibitors will be required to obtain a release certificate from Department Superintendent before he loads his livestock. Release certificate blank forms will be available at the Livestock Office on Sunday.

It will not be necessary to make entries in the Champion Classes and no entry fee will be charged for winners in Champion Classes. See further rules under **Rules and Regulations**.

REQUIREMENTS AND CRITERIA

Please read all Rules and Regulations as listed below.

1. Each Exhibitor must comply with the General Eligibility Rules.
2. Wethers must have been born on or after October 1, 2009 and have milk teeth. Milk teeth will be checked at weigh-in by Superintendent and show committee.
3. The Junior Meat Goat Wether show is a tattoo show. All goats wethers must be tattooed in the name of the exhibitor by designated personnel. Wethers must be identified by a legible, fully healed tattoo matching the number designated on the original entry card. Exhibitor is responsible for having his/her animals ears clean, knowing where the tattoo is and knowing it can be read by officials at time of entry processing. DO NOT bring an animal with: no tattoo, fresh tattoo, non-legible or a tattoo that does not match entry card designation.
4. Goats must be on grounds by 7 a.m., Tuesday. Wethers will be weighed Tuesday at 7:30 a.m.. Junior weight will be honored in the open show. Wether classes will be determined and posted by Superintendents after weigh in.
5. The A.B.G.A. Association rules will govern the show.
6. Artificial coloring will be disqualified.
7. Drug Testing Provision - Department personnel may collect blood, tissue or urine samples from any goat being exhibited to test for the presence of illegal drugs.
8. The Illinois Humane Care for Animals Act prohibits physical mistreatment of animals. The use of electrical shock or withholding of feed or water are considered direct violations of the Act. The presence of any type of equipment to induce electrical show in the exhibition are will be considered as intent to inflict electrical shock on animals under care of the person with the equipment. Persons found mistreating goats shall be prohibited from exhibiting and dismissed from the fairgrounds.
9. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST CLEAN OWN STALLS. Pens must be cleaned at dismissal to receive premiums.
10. All goats released immediately following show.
