SUBJECT: Field Day Items

Animal Health: To exhibit in Maryland you will need health papers. These need to be with you at the show and will be checked by the management committee. In addition you need to complete the “**Livestock Exhibitor’s Self-Certification of Animal Health.**” A copy is enclosed. Please bring it completed to the show. It will be collected. If you forget, a copy will be available for you to fill out. For further information please refer to: www.mda.state.md.us/animal_health/fair_show

BEDDING: Animals must be bedded on **straw**. Our bedding contract will only accept straw and manure. No trash or other bedding eg. tan bark or shavings. Exhibitors are required to clean up their stall area and dispose of the straw bedding in the designated area.

FITTING: There is to be **NO** painting of animals at the show. Aerosols are **NOT ALLOWED** at ringside.

JUDGING CONTEST: There will be a junior judging contest on Saturday morning. ALL exhibitors are expected to provide animals if asked.

DEPARTURE: All animals must be gone from the fairgrounds by 6:00 P.M. to allow the committee time to clean up.

MD SHORTHORN AMBASSADOR: Entries are due to Sue Kline no later than June 14, 2010

EASTERN REGIONAL DINNER: There will be a dinner sponsored by the MD shorthorn association and the Junior Association following the steer show. Exhibitors are asked to bring a dessert. Everything else will be furnished.
